Title: Trust, Fear, and Honor the LORD

Text: Proverbs 3:1–12 (ESV)

¹My son, do not forget my teaching, but let your heart keep my commandments,

- ² for length of days and years of life and peace they will add to you.
- ³ Let not steadfast love and faithfulness forsake you; bind them around your neck; write them on the tablet of your heart.
- ⁴ So you will find favor and good success in the sight of God and man.
- ⁵ Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding.
- ⁶ In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.
- 7 Be not wise in your own eyes; fear the LORD, and turn away from evil.
- 8 It will be healing to your flesh and refreshment to your bones.
- 9 Honor the LORD with your wealth and with the firstfruits of all your produce;
- then your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will be bursting with wine.

- My son, do not despise the LORD's discipline or be weary of his reproof,
- for the LORD reproves him whom he loves, as a father the son in whom he delights.

Introduction: Solomon continues to instruct his son in hopes that he will choose the path of wisdom. This passage begins with the father's appeal (1-4), followed by his instruction (5-10). It concludes with a warning against resisting discipline (11-12). The point of the passage is basic and vital to the life.

Today's take-home truth: Well-being only comes to those who live in right relation to the LORD.

I. A godly father's appeal: Don't waste the advantages my teaching offers you. 1-4

- A. My teaching gives life and peace if you obey it. 1-2
- B. My teaching produces right relationships with God and man if you hold on to it. 3-4

II. His instruction: Live for the LORD, not for yourself—that is the path to true well-being. 5-10

- A. Trust the LORD and he will guide you. 5-6
- B. Fear the LORD and he will "heal" you. 7-8
- C. Honor the LORD and he will bless you. 9-10

III. A warning: You will fail, but the LORD will help you. 11-12

- A. Value the LORD's discipline . . . 11
- B. As a sign of his love. 12
